



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
BETWEEN
MINISTRY OF HEALTH THE FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ETHIOPIA
AND
YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD**

This Memorandum of Understanding (the “MoU”) is made as of 23rd April 2018 by and between Federal Ministry of Health, Ethiopia, Sudan St, P.O.Box 1234, Addis Ababa and YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD, a Georgia non-profit corporation with its principal place of business at P.O. Box 2824, Lilburn, Georgia 30048 and

WHEREAS, YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD is a 501 (C) 3 Organization operating under the guidelines as published by the Internal Revenue Service of the United States of America. The EIN number for YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD is **82-0732696. Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation. LTD. business was incorporated on March 22, 2017 in the State of Georgia, USA. TIGIST A DEMISSE is the incorporator and CEO of the organization. The organization received its 501 (C) 3 letter from the Internal Revenue Services of the United States on October 24th 2017 with an effective look back date of March 22, 2017, the date of incorporation.**

WHEREAS, YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD is duly registered as a non-profit organization in USA and it is developing project plan to operate in accordance with rules established by the government of Ethiopia. Country Representative will be assigned to work closely with the relevant stakeholders.

WHEREAS, YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD is authorized to solicit donations and provide charitable fundraising activities in the United States and certain foreign countries, including fundraising via internet and mobile telephone technology, and solicitation of grants from foundations and governmental agencies. The web site for the organization is under development.

WHEREAS, Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation’s mission is to organize, develop and operate a new 500 bed medical treatment facility in Sululta, one of the woredas (districts) in the Oromia Region of Ethiopia. Our goal is to implement medical treatment for those in poverty. Our services will be provided *WITHOUT CHARGE* as charitable services for financially qualified patients.

Whereas, YEABE MEDICAL CENTER & REHABILITATION, LTD would provide technical and material support to public health facilities without charge as a charitable service.

Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation, LTD is engaged in, among other things, **establishing collaborative partners to accomplish short term goals:**

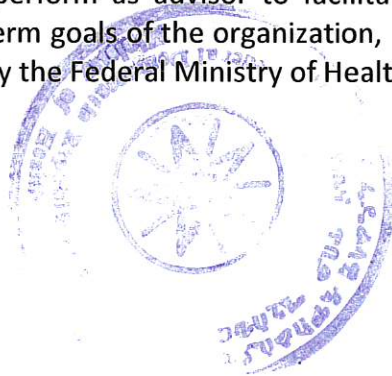

1. We seek to collaborate with the Health Ministry of Ethiopia and other Grantors to promote wellness and organize health fairs; including specialty workshops for health and wellness for women and children.
2. We seek to collaborate with the Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia and other Grantors to establish a specialty clinic for pregnancy monitoring with ultrasound diagnostics; including the implementation of telemedicine and electronic medical records technology for female health extension workers and midwives to reduce infant mortality in the Sululta, Oromia Region of Ethiopia.
3. We seek to collaborate with the Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia and other Grantors to provide disease prevention services; including inoculation and vaccination services as provided for the broader population of our community, while collaborating with the Ministry of Health of Ethiopia, the CDC and World Health Organization.
4. We seek to collaborate with the Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia and other Grantors to lead and participate in organizing educational and research activities for specific diseases. For Example; we intend to electronically record health data for major vector and vector borne disease research such as Malaria. Malaria is responsible for 8.3 of all outpatient visits in Ethiopian hospitals where clinical diagnosis is made without laboratory confirmation, (1.), and an additional 3.7 outpatient visits are for Malaria (confirmed with species other than *Plasmodium falciparum*). Malaria accounts for approximately 12% of outpatient visits to medical facilities in Ethiopia

WHEREAS, Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia currently oversees health programs for Ethiopia, and further collaborates with the World Health Organization, the World Bank and other organizations to secure financing and support the promotion of health for Ethiopians.



Now, therefore Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia and **Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation , LTD agree to the following terms** whereby each shall participate as a Collaborative Partner to support and assist in the development of the Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation , LTD hospital and medical facilities, including to perform as advisor to facilitate Yeabe Medical Center & Rehabilitation , LTD achievement of short term goals of the organization, whereby such goals will mutually benefit existing programs as provided by the Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia.
